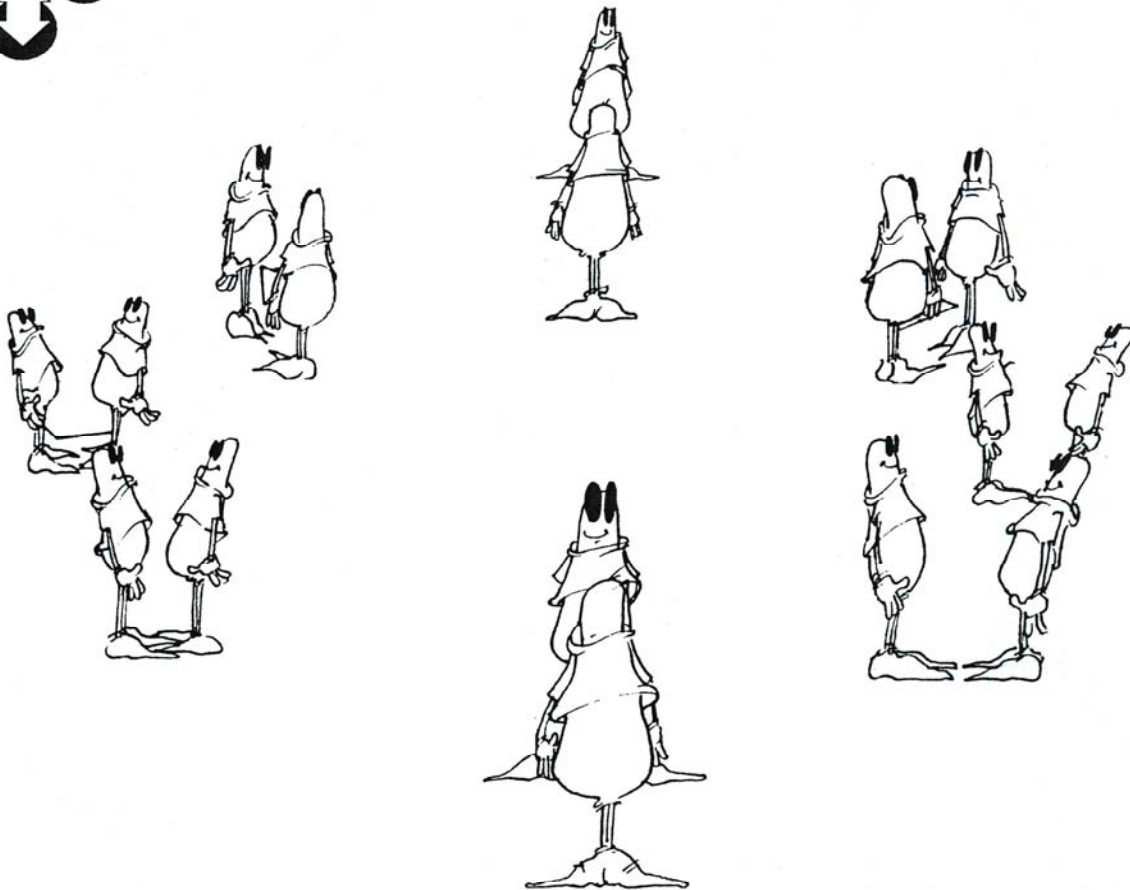


Mix - Freeze - Group



This structure is good for review questions only if they have a number for an answer. Students mill about the room. The teacher calls "Freeze." The teacher then asks a question, such as "How many players are there on a baseball team?" Students are to quickly group according to the answer, the students left over are to go to "lost and Found," which is by the teacher. The rule is that you cannot go to Lost and Found two times in a row, so on the next question, classmates group first with those from Lost and Found.
